

The Pennsylvania PTA hereby calls its constituent associations to send accredited delegates and non-voting members to its 109<sup>th</sup> Annual Convention to be held October 19-21, 2018, at the Ambassador Center in Erie, PA.

#### Cyberbullying (Online bullying, online harassment, online stalking)

This was adopted by the Board of Managers in January 2010 and amended in 2018.

#### **Extraction of Natural Gas (Fracking)**

This was adopted by the Board of Managers in October 2012 and amended in 2018.

## Pennsylvania PTA Resolutions

The following Pennsylvania PTA Resolutions will be presented during the General Meeting at Convention. You can view the documents in their entirety online at <a href="https://www.papta.org">www.papta.org</a>.

#### **CAREER EDUCATION**

Adopted by the Pennsylvania PTA in 1977, it is being marked as accomplished.

Rationale: It is state mandated that school districts offer career education as an equal opportunity path after graduation. Information contained in the Resolution is outdated and no longer viable.

#### COOPERATION WITH EDUCATION RELATED ORGANIZATIONS

Adopted by the Pennsylvania PTA in 1989, it is being marked as accomplished.

Rationale: It is listed under the duties of the Pennsylvania PTA to work with education-focused organizations and associations.

#### HELMET USE AND BICYCLE SAFETY

Adopted by the Pennsylvania PTA in 1997, it is being marked as accomplished.

Rationale: The Resolved Clauses have been accomplished. It is a Pennsylvania law that riders under the age of 12 must wear a helmet when riding a bicycle.

#### COMMUNITY USE OF SCHOOL FACILITIES

Adopted by the Pennsylvania PTA in 1991, it is being rescinded.

Rationale: NPTA has a Resolution which covers all action required in the Resolved Clauses and includes up to date information. Pennsylvania PTA will continue to advocate for and promote the use of school facilities, free of charge, to not for profit education-related associations that improve communities. NPTA Resolutions are written to be national in scope for use in advocating efforts in every state.

#### **CERTIFIED ATHLETIC TRAINERS**

Adopted by the Pennsylvania PTA in 1991, it is being presented to be amended by substitution.

#### FAMILY CHOICE

Adopted by the Pennsylvania PTA in 1991, it is being presented to be amended by substitution.

#### SCHOOL TO WORK PROGRAMS

Adopted by the Pennsylvania PTA in 1995, it is being presented to be amended by substitution.

#### PRESCHOOL VISION SCREENING FOR AMBLYOPIA and STRABISMUS

Adopted by the Pennsylvania PTA in 1992, it has been reviewed in 2018.

## **Helpful Hints for Convention**

#### **Convention Registration Procedure**

Each delegate must send the completed Convention Registration Form and <u>one</u> yellow Voter ID Card (centerfold) to the Pennsylvania PTA office for processing. Mail completed registration form, Voter ID Card and payment to: Pennsylvania PTA, 4804 Derry Street, Harrisburg, PA 17111.

#### **Voter Identification Cards**

Four yellow ID Cards are included in the center of this publication. In order to vote at Convention, each delegate must have their own original Voter Identification Card. Additional cards are available on request from the Pennsylvania PTA Office. No photocopies will be accepted.

If representing a local PTA / PTSA, the Card must be <u>signed</u> by the president of the local unit being represented. If representing a council, the card must be signed by both the president of the council being represented and the president of a local PTA / PTSA in which delegate is a member. Council delegates (either the council president or alternate) must indicate the name of the council on the Voter ID Card.

Everyone attending Convention must have their own Voter ID Card, which must be submitted with the Convention Registration Form.

#### **Confirmations**

The Pennsylvania PTA office will acknowledge pre-registrations with a confirmation (e-mail or letter) and additional information. Please bring this letter with you when you register at the convention.

#### Cancellations

Registration refund requests must be made by **September 28**, in writing, to the Pennsylvania PTA office. No refunds can be issued after this date.

#### Attire

Business-Casual attire is recommended for the workshops and general meetings. Due to the fluctuation in temperatures between meeting rooms in the hotel, it is recommended that you have a light jacket or sweater on hand. For the Saturday evening banquet, either business-dress or semi-formal attire is appropriate.
