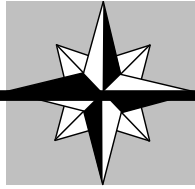

“The PTA Passport to Leadership Program was designed to recognize PTA members for their commitment to leadership and non-profit management education. PTA offers you the opportunity to be recognized for the advancement of your own personal learning goals, in your service to children and families.”

How does the "Passport to Leadership Recognition Program" work?

This program is based on the concept of continuing education credits accrued for attendance at workshops and programs held at the regional, state and levels by Pennsylvania PTA members.

How do I earn credits?

A member can earn credits in this self-reporting system by completing a "Passport to Leadership" reporting form (*see back page*). It is the responsibility of the Passport member to submit the form at the completion of the event/program. Because of the complexity of tracking "Continuing Leadership Credits" over time, only those credits reported on provided forms will be accrued toward leadership awards.

A record of these credits will be kept in the state PTA office for all those who register for the program. In the spring, the credits will be tallied and members achieving each level of leadership will be recognized at the annual convention with the presentation of their leadership awards, and by announcement in *PTA in Pennsylvania*.
